PERFORMANCE NOTES:

Sing in your range (as written, or down 8va). If performing online, use headphones.

Make no effort to stay in tempo. Everyone should sing through each phrase in their own time.

When you reach a fermata, hold that rest until everyone has reached the silence, then continue.

The conductor may cue the start of each phrase after a fermata. They should also sing with the choir.

Whenever two or more notes are given, pick one. Feel free to jump around; choose an upper note for a few beats, then a lower note, etc. Don't feel confined to singing only the lower voice or upper voice throughout.

One or two soloists should be decided ahead of time (for m. 14-21 and m. 34-42). Online solos may work better with lower voices. If not performing virtually, singers should stand at least 6 feet apart from each other and still follow these instructions.
